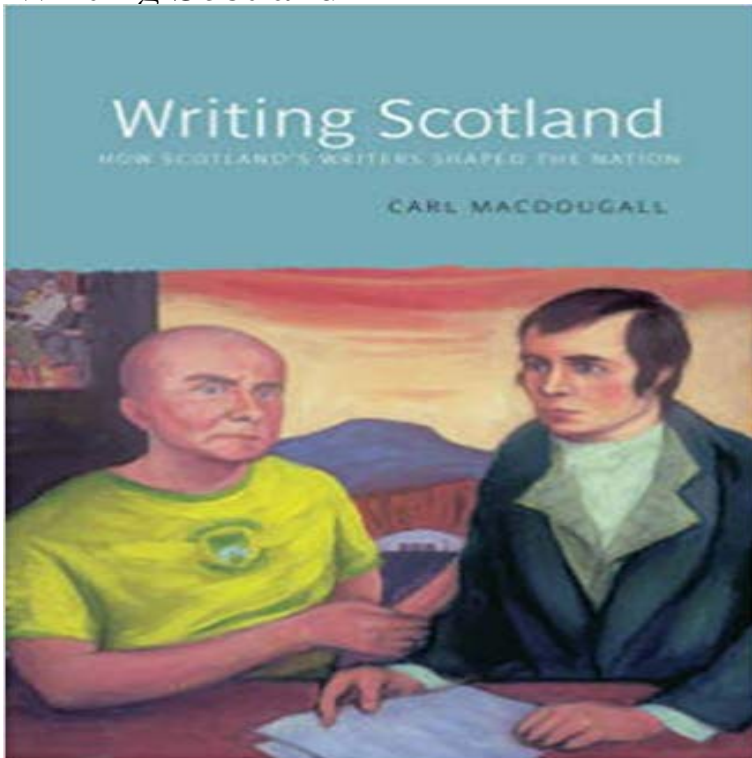


## Writing Scotland
