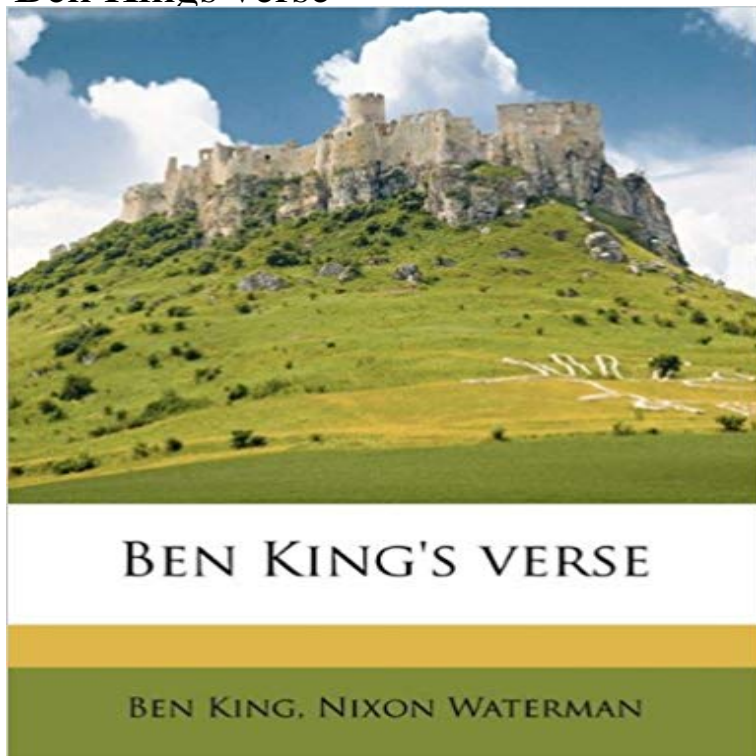


Ben Kings verse
