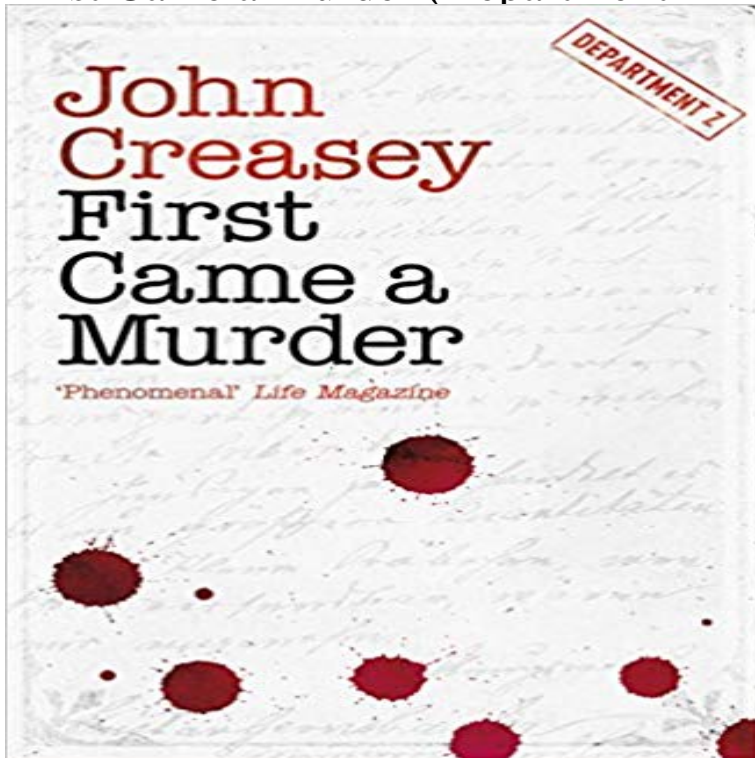


## First Came a Murder (Department Z Book 3)
