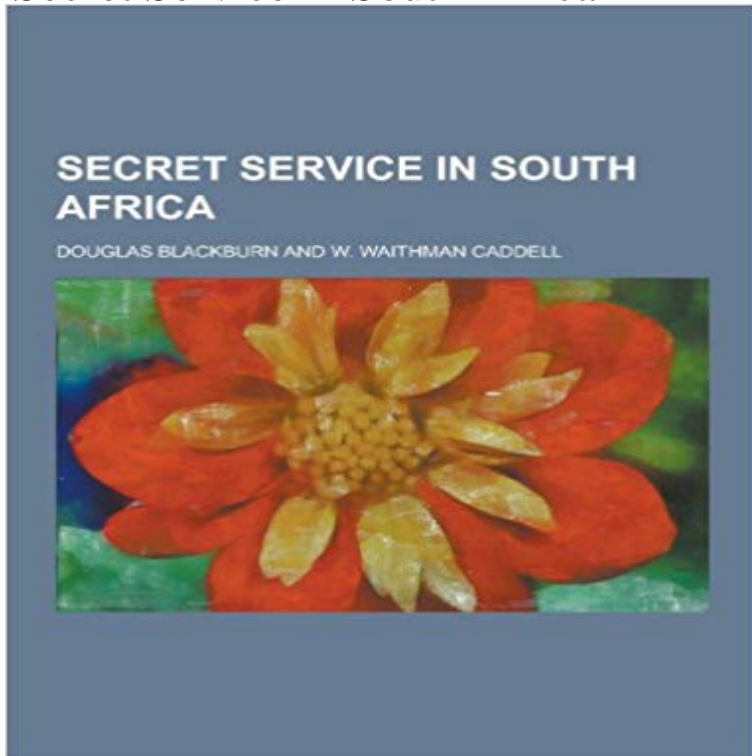

But the Transvaal illicit liquor detective department was inaugurated out of regard, not for the ethical, but for the business side of the matter.
