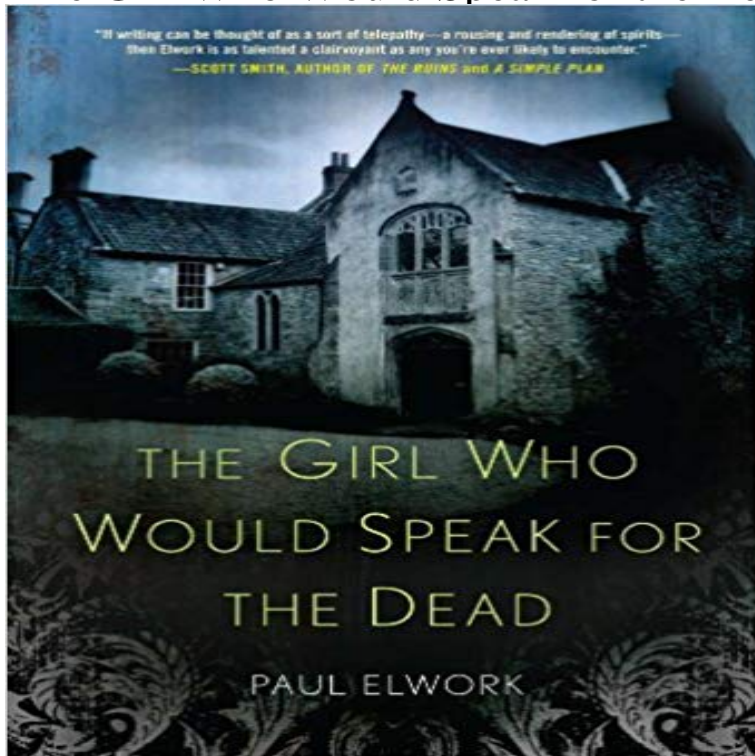


The Girl Who Would Speak for the Dead
