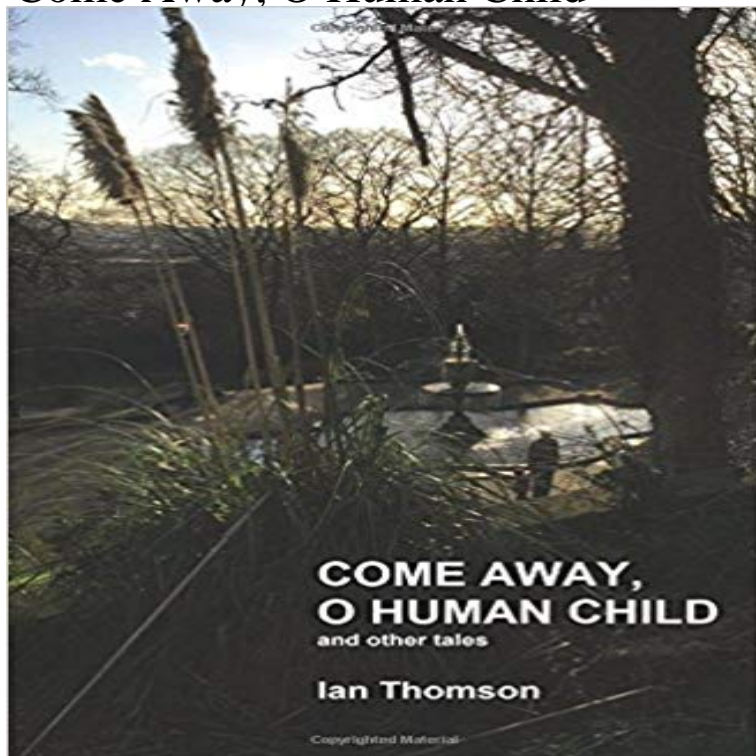


## Come Away, O Human Child
